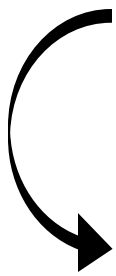
**INQUIRIES** What's your code, your ethics? Society's code? What principles drive the code?

**BIG IDEAS** 1] A person's principles about right and wrong determine his ethics, or moral code. His code guides his behavior and treatment of others.

2] Societies, groups, and institutions also have ethics. A group's moral code is shaped by the principles of its creators or dominant members. Groups use their ethics as a tool by which to judge the conduct and character of others.

3] Your relationship to society, therefore, is partly based on how closely your ethics line up (or don't line up) with the code of the larger group.
