SOPHIE SCHOLL



Background

Sophie Scholl was a 21-year-old college student in Germany during the Holocaust – the movement by Adolf Hitler’s Nazi Party to kill all of Europe’s Jewish people. Scholl was a member of a non-violent resistance group against the Nazis known as the White Rose. The group wrote and distributed anti-Nazi papers in the German city of Munich. As a result of her activism against the Nazis, Scholl was arrested and executed by guillotine (she was beheaded) on February 22, 1943.

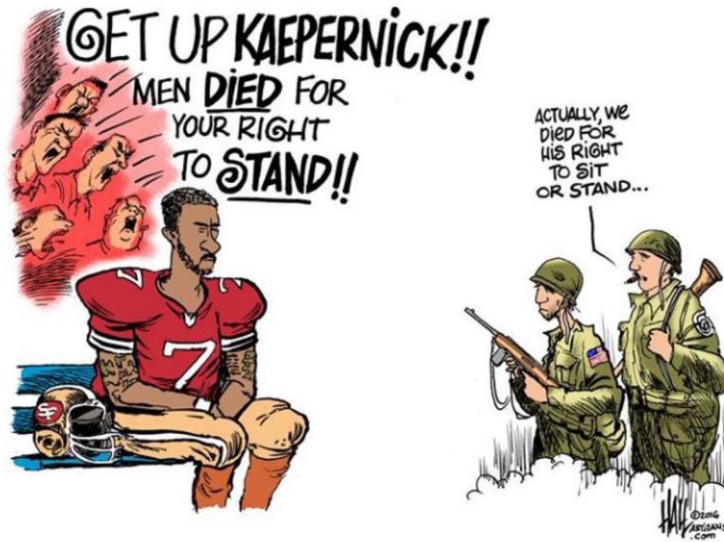
Quotes

1. The real damage [in times like this when Nazis are killing so many] is done by those millions [of observers] who want to ‘survive’ -- the honest men who just want to be left in peace, those who don’t want their little lives disturbed by anything bigger than themselves, those with no sides and no causes...those who don’t like to [make enemies].
2. Stand up for what you believe in, even if you are standing alone.
3. Such a fine, sunny day, and I have to go [die], but what does my death matter, if through us, thousands of people are awakened and stirred to action?
