
Development and Inequity

Idea # 1

Inequity prevents equality.

Geographic inequity is a barrier to economic equality.

Idea # 2

Food is critical for success.

(MORE SPECIFICALLY)

Access to food (and therefore health) impacts development.

Food affects society's

Opportunities (economy),

Outlook (worldview), and

Destiny (future outcome).

How will we explore this idea -- that our access to food affects our attitudes, our opportunities, and our future?

1. **LITERACY**: We will analyze 2 cultures (*Leavers & Takers*) who access food and live very differently.
2. **CIVGAME**: We will conduct research to see which regions of the world are set up with strategic food advantages.
