## PROCESS

## CATEGORIES OF STUDY

POLITICAL news focuses on government, laws and rights, military action, and international relations.

SOCIAL news focuses on culture (religion, sport, art, lifestyle), health, education, crime, and group relations.

ECONOMIC news focuses on wealth, work, development, investment, infrastructure, production, and trade.

INTELLECTUAL news focuses on ideas, knowledge, discoveries, science, technology, and innovation.

GEOGRAPHIC news focuses on resources, environment, natural events, and population (size, movement).
